Who we are:

LeadMN represents 180,000 two-year college students that come to Minnesota from every corner of the world to transform their lives and their communities. The American Dream has long been a symbol of achieving success. For far too many Minnesotans, the path to this dream is impeded due to systematic barriers. At LeadMN we break down those barriers by empowering two-year college students to become strong leaders, engaged community members, and successful professionals. Position:

Over the last five-year LeadMN's Health Equity campaign has focused on helping students address food insecurity and mental health issues. Over the next year we want to expand this effort to address vaccine hesitancy amongst college students. This Internship position will focus mainly on engaging students at two-year Community College campuses. We are looking for four interns for four open positions.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The Public health Interns will work closely with the Outreach Director to carry out LeadMN's Covid outreach plans by supporting engagement on eight campuses until May 2022.

Planning

- Engage with nursing students to help with outreach efforts
- Plan an information session on campus for students to engage in dialogue about vaccine hesitancy
- Explore if and how Minnesota State-Moorhead campus would benefit from having a covid clinic hosted on site
- Help the outreach director develop a student survey to better understand students' attitudes about the vaccine

Campus Engagement

- Work with students to share stories about their vaccination experience/journey
- Create a working group with nursing students interested in covid outreach to advance engagement on campuses

Implementation

- Attend a bi-weekly statewide cohort meeting
- Develop social media ads for covid related events and share with partners
- Complete surveys report of attendees at events
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- Must be majoring in public health, nursing or social work and attend one of the two-year institutions
- Be able to work in a fast pace working environment
- Clear understanding of health inequity
- Should be able to work independently
